**Methodology**

The school data contained in the LIFE Report has been collected and presented in a manner that best represents our students and the demographic differences among them. Students who live in Wood County live in a variety of different environments—(i.e. small cities, rural townships, villages)-- and often do not share the same experiences. Parents have opportunities to send students to public, private, public charter schools, home school, and public alternative schools.

**Public and Private School Data**

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) collects certain public and private school data. Wherever possible in the LIFE Report, that source is used for statistical information. Data not available through the DPI WebPages has been collected from schools directly.

Throughout this report, information is presented on enrollment, graduates, academics, student extra- and co-curricular activities and finance. This is just a snapshot of what education is about, with students in the center of that picture.
